COASTAL ORGANIZATIONS USE THIS FORM

What: This year's Rougarou Fest in downtown Houma will be Saturday, October 21, 2017 from 10am to 10pm and Sunday, October 22, 2017 from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. The Rougarou Fest is a family-friendly festival with a spooky flair that celebrates the rich folklore that exists along the bayous of Southeast Louisiana. It is also the primary fundraiser supporting the South Louisiana Wetlands Discovery Center, a nonprofit, tax exempt organization, that is revolutionizing how we think, teach and learn about Louisiana's disappearing coast.

When: On Saturday, October 21, 2017 booths MUST operate between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. Coastal organizations are welcome to remain open until 10 p.m. when the event ends. On Sunday, October 22, 2017 booths MUST operate from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Vendors may choose to operate on just one day or both days.

How: Coastal organizations will be assigned a 10x10 space and are responsible for providing thier own tent, tables, chairs, lighting, extension cords, garbage cans and change. An ATM machine will be available on festival grounds.

Where: Booths will be located in the area surrounding the courthouse square.

Booth Fee: Booths are free for coastal organizations.
