What: This year’s Rougarou Fest in downtown Houma will be Saturday, October 20, 2018 from 10AM to 10PM and Sunday, October 21, 2018 from 10AM to 5PM The Rougarou Fest is a family-friendly festival with a spooky flair that celebrates the rich folklore that exists along the bayous of Southeast Louisiana. It is also the primary fundraiser supporting the South Louisiana Wetlands Discovery Center, a nonprofit, tax-exempt organization, that is revolutionizing how we think, teach and learn about Louisiana’s disappearing coast.

When: On Saturday, October 20, 2018 booths MUST operate between 10AM and 4PM. Coastal Organizations are welcome to remain open until 10PM when the event ends. On Sunday, October 21, 2018 booths MUST operate from 10AM to 4PM. Vendors may choose to operate on just one day or both days.

How: Coastal Organizations will be assigned a 10x10 space and are responsible for providing their own tent, tables, chairs, lighting, extension cords and garbage cans.

Where: Booths will be located in the area surrounding the courthouse square.

Booth Fee: Booths are free for Coastal Organizations.
