What: This year's Rougarou Fest vendor market in Houma will be Saturday, October 23, 2021 from 10AM to 10PM and Sunday, October 24, 2021 from 10AM to 5PM. The Rougarou Fest is a family-friendly festival with a spooky flair that celebrates the rich folklore that exists along the bayous of Southeast Louisiana. It is also the primary fundraiser supporting the South Louisiana Wetlands Discovery Center, a nonprofit, tax-exempt organization, that is revolutionizing how we think, teach and learn about Louisiana's disappearing coast.

When: On Saturday, October 23, 2021 booths MUST operate between 10AM and 10PM. On Sunday, October 24, 2021 booths MUST operate from 10AM to 5PM.

How: Vendors will be assigned a 10x10 space and are responsible for providing their own tent, tables, chairs, lighting, 100 foot extension cord, garbage cans and change. An ATM machine will be available on festival grounds. All items for sale MUST be handmade or personally designed.

Where: Booths will be located on the festival grounds near the Houma-Terrebonne Civic Center in Houma.

Booth Fee: \$75 per 10x10 space. There will be no refunds in the event of inclement weather. Booth spaces are to be reserved on a first-come first-served basis once payment has been received. \$25 extra for electricity. NOT ALL VENDORS ARE ACCEPTED. If your application is not accepted, all fees will be returned.
