This year's Rougarou Fest in Houma will be Friday, October 22, 2021 from 5PM to 10PM, Saturday, October 23, 2021 from 10AM to 10PM and Sunday, October 24, 2021 from 10AM to 5PM. The Rougarou Fest is a family-friendly festival with a spooky flair that celebrates the rich folklore that exists along the bayous of Southeast Louisiana. It is also the primary fundraiser supporting the South Louisiana Wetlands Discovery Center, a nonprofit, tax-exempt organization, that is revolutionizing how we think, teach and learn about Louisiana's disappearing coast.

On **Saturday, October 23, 2021** booths operate between **10AM and 8PM**. On **Sunday, October 24, 2021** booths operate from **10AM to 5PM**. Booths must operate both days. Booths will not operate on Friday. Please decorate your tent with a spooky or Louisiana theme.

- Rougarou Fest sponsors are given priority to participate. There is no fee for participation.
- Each business or organization will be assigned a 10x10 space. We ask that you provide your own tent, lighting and extension cords. We will provide one 8 foot table and two chairs.
- Rougarou Fest can provide a craft activity or a game and prizes upon request. Any craft or game created by a business must have prior approval.
- All booths will accept Rougarou Fest tickets only. No cash transactions are allowed.
- One banner that identifies your business or organization can be hung across the back of your tent.
- Wearing company shirts to promote your business is encouraged.
- We are working on our goal of making Rougarou Fest a Zero Waste Event! To move towards this goal, we are asking all vendors and organizations to not pass out any paper. Instead of handing out paper, we ask all of our vendors and organizations to provide a visual at your booth (flyer, poster) and encourage interested festival goers to take a picture of the information that interests them.
- Although businesses are not allowed to hand out any printed materials (business cards, flyers, brochures, etc.), a kid-friendly promotional prize with your company logo can be given.
