## KREWE GA ROU PARADE

### PARADE INFO & REGULATIONS

[Parade rolls at 7:00PM, Saturday, October 21, 2023]

The Krewe Ga Rou Parade will be held on Saturday, October 21, 2023 in conjunction with the Rougarou Fest sponsored by the South Louisiana Wetlands Discovery Center. The parade begins at 7:00PM and finishes at approximately 8:30PM. All participants must arrive by 6:00PM, so that all groups may be placed in the parade line-up.

The parade will begin and end in the Houma-Terrebonne Civic Center parking lot. A copy of the line-up list and a map will be emailed to participants prior to the event. The Houma Police Department and the Terrebonne Parish Sheriff's office will be in charge of security.

#### PARADE ROUTE:

- Starts near the intersection of Barrow St. and Civic Center Blvd., turns right onto Civic Center Blvd., turns right onto HWY 311, turns right onto Barrow St., turns right into the Civic Center parking lot to disband.
- The route is approximately 1 mile long. \*Route subject to change.

#### \$100 FEE:

- The fee to participate is \$100 for each specialty vehicle or walking group.
- This fee helps to defray the cost of permits, security and insurance required for this event.
- In the event of inclement weather, the rain date will be Sunday, October 22, 2023 at 2PM.
- In the event the parade does not roll, application fees will be rolled over to 2024 or refunded.

#### SPECIALTY VEHICLES:

- Adults over 18 may pull decorated boats on trailers (boats must be under 25 feet), drive decorated specialty vehicles including 4 wheelers, go-carts, golf carts, lawn mowers, trailers, hayrides, or other small vehicles.
- Adults on or in vehicles operate those vehicles at their own risk.
- Children driving motorized vehicles are not permitted.
- If your specialty vehicle requires music, you must provide your own sound system, and the lyrics must not be offensive.
- If you are driving a motor vehicle in the parade, driver's license and proof of insurance must be submitted with the application.
- Children under the age of 18 MUST be accompanied by a group chaperone (one adult per every 8 children).
- Boats being pulled as floats must remove or disconnect the gas tank while being pulled in the parade.
- Party buses are not allowed.

#### WALKING GROUPS:

- Walking groups are invited to participate and can pull decorated children's wagons.
- Each walking group will be allowed one motorized vehicle, if necessary, to carry sound equipment, water, candy, and supplies.
- If your group requires music, you must provide your own sound system, and the lyrics must not be offensive.
- Children under the age of 18 MUST be accompanied by a group chaperone (one adult per every 8 children).

## COSTUMES REQUIRED:

- All participants are required to dress in appropriate costumes or themed uniforms approved by parade staff.
- SLWDC reserves the right to prevent any participant from riding on a float or walking in the parade if it deems any costume offensive.

## ONLY CANDY:

- Each parade participant **MUST THROW CANDY**.
- Only wrapped candy is allowed.
- To prevent injury, thrown candy may not be in large bags.
- Participants must provide their own candy.

## NOT ALLOWED:

- No glass containers allowed
- No throwing of: large bags of candy, rolls of toilet paper, plastic beads, or alcohol/jello shots
- No party buses
- Political campaign signs are not permitted in the parade as per Parish Ordinance Section 19-46 (d)
- No explicit music - The "Explicit" label applies when the lyrics or content of a song contain one or more of the following criteria which could be considered offensive or unsuitable for children: Strong language; References to violence, physical, or mental abuse; References to sexual behaviour; Discriminatory language.
